## **Quick Facts: Reading**

- Approximately 60 minutes (this includes the convening students, distributing materials, practice items, and scored items. Tier B/C will take longer than Tier A. Visit your member/state page of the <u>WIDA website</u> (<a href="https://wida.wisc.edu">https://wida.wisc.edu</a>) for any additional state and district test timing guidance that applies to your students).
- · Completely computer-delivered.
- Equipment needed: desktop, laptop, or tablet; headphones.
- Materials needed: Online Test Administration Manual, Test Administrator Script, Student Test Tickets, and Student Test Roster.
- Make sure the Internet connection is functioning on the devices used to administer the test.
- · Follow the Test Administrator Script exactly.
- Encourage students to ask questions before the Reading Test begins.
- Test Administrator should circulate the room to monitor students' progress.
- After the test has ended, ensure that every student has turned in his or her Test Ticket.
